Principal's Message:

- **Jog-a-thon**: We have met our Jog-A-thon fund raising goal.
- Parent Teacher Conference Updates:
 - Held the second week of November, 20-minute conferences (in-person and Zoom).
 - o Information will be sent out in the October 28 newsletter.
- Earthquake Drill: During Kinder lunch, students adjusted well. <u>Kudos</u> to the kinders for being resilient and accommodating!

BSD Cell Phone and Device Usage Engagement Process:

Digital Device Survey and Engagement Process

- The district has distributed a survey to gather input on digital device usage in schools.
- All 57 schools in the district are participating, with an emphasis on keeping students focused on learning.

Purpose:

- The survey aims to collect feedback regarding the future use of cell phones and digital devices in schools.
- Oak Hills Elementary is engaging parents through the PTO meeting and will conduct similar discussions with teachers.
- Initial focus groups results will be consolidated and reviewed at the district level by December.

Process:

- Principal Thao Do-Gwilliam's presentation outlines the initiative and the process schools are engaging in.
- Discussions within OHS will also take place with 4th and 5th graders to include student perspectives.

Discussion Prompts:

 Principal Thao Do-Gwilliam also shared some prompts with the group to gather initial responses and answers.

PTO Business:

- Approval for 2024 May meeting budget passed.
- Bylaw changes:
 - Executive board positions will have two people.
 - Teachers and principals serve as consults, not core members.
 - Budget increase approval raised to \$500.
 - Guardians can now vote in PTO.

BYLAWS were approved and passed by the members and attendees.

Upcoming Events:

Now:

- Fall fest, Jog-a-thon tickets, movie night (Dec 6)
- Global Fair (Feb 6).

Next:

After school clubs:

- The first club session was held on October 15, featuring pumpkin templates, and butterflies for KG, with 23 participants. More volunteers are needed, as only 3 were available per session.
- Clubs are held in portable 6, and announcements were made in the newsletter to raise awareness. A raffle may be introduced to boost interest.
- The first after-school club, supported by Mrs. Larsen, starts on October 29 and will run for 4 weeks on Tuesdays. Registration is required.
- A robotics club for K-2 students is planned for the new year.

Future:

Fifth Grade celebration committee

- A party is planned for the last Friday of the year, and the team is still trying to find a lead for the event.
- A newsletter will be sent to all parents, including ALC parents, to communicate updates.
- The blue bag program, featuring a QR code for the PTO, helps raise funds by collecting old bottles and cans throughout the year. Fifth graders can assist if others are unable to drop off bottles.
- Fall Fest will offer cash-only food items,

Volunteer Coordinator:

- An FAQ for teachers is being developed, and grade representative teams have been established for this year.
- Efforts are underway to determine how teachers can manage their own posts and how VC can serve as admins.
- Over 500 volunteers have been approved through Raptor, with middle and high school students getting immediate approval.
- BSD supports the Clothes for Kids program, accepting clothing donations and allowing the community to shop, with a drive scheduled for Dec 17-19 at Oak Hills.

PTO Budget and Treasurer Report:

- \$50K has been raised with potential for an additional \$2,500, totaling around \$55K.
- Budgets for Jog-a-thon t-shirts and field trips have already been finalized, and PTO funds are allocated for event lights.
- White envelopes are used for funding class parties, "On the Move," and Art Lit, though many were unaware of this.

Votes are needed for:

- \$1,600 for class parties (\$3 per kid for two parties).
- A potential budget increase for "On the Move" to be revisited at year-end.
- Increasing the family events budget by \$1,900 to bring the overall budget line item to \$5,000 (vote passed).

All votes approved and passed.

- Two field trips are booked for two classes (\$1,900), with a vote approved for \$20 per student for two field trips per grade, one of which could be an enrichment opportunity.
- Budget updates will require ongoing approvals.
