- 2. Parent Question: There are student reports that running is not being allowed on bark chips/playground structure at all. There is also no running on the blacktop and fields are closed. What are current recess rules; when can children run; if these report are accurate, why was this change implemented?
 - a. RESPONSE:
 - b. Yes, they have stopped allowing running on the bark
 - c. Students are allowed to run while actively playing basketball or on the fields (which have been closed)
 - d. There was an uptick in health room visits due to unsafe play happening. Some of this is related to a greater number of kids concentrated on the bark as fields are

- closed. Some of this is due to students engaging in activity that has always been against the rules (eg, jumping from swings and jumping off playground structures).
- e. Staff ask for parent patience as they use the next couple weeks to implement a reteach of recess rules
